PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION

Authorization for the Sudbury Public School Nursing Staff to dispense prescription medications.

Prescription medications *require* a doctor's order. This completed form or the physician's own form is required along with the medication in a *pharmacy labeled* bottle for the nurse to legally administer prescription medication.

Antibiotics, which need to be taken on a short-term basis, can be given without a doctor's order. In this case the pharmacy labeled bottle will serve as the doctor's order.
